Teacher certification process

Students who graduate with a graduate degree leading to teacher certification receive an institutional recommendation from ASU for the listed teacher certification from the Arizona Department of Education.

Endorsements are attachments to teaching certificates and indicate areas of specialization. Optional endorsements may be required by local governing boards.



Those desiring to teach in a public school must pass the appropriate educator exams (National Evaluation Series or Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessments) to be certified to teach in the state of Arizona.
